


Class of 2026:

4-5 Leg Relay Race

Track field would be used for this event. 4 sets of 3 player teams (1st -4th Positions) are stationed around the track (legs tied). 1st position starts and passes their baton to the next team as quickly as possible.

The last set of players consists of a 4 person team (5th position) and would race to the finish **WITH the Team Baton**.





Capture The Flag Tag

This is basically a game of tag but instead of tagging, the object is to capture any opposing team's flag hanging from their t-shirt (back).

Once a player's flag is taken, they are out and must walk to the sidelines. The player who captured the flag must then return it to their **BASE** without getting captured themselves! They must return one flag at a time before heading out again.

The teams try to capture the most flags until one team is left standing on the field or before the end of the time period.

Pizza Box Stack Race

Players for each team are lined up in the endzone. Each Delivery player balances 10 pizza boxes. They must make their way to the other end zone while avoiding the obstacles of students holding pool noodles to knock the pizza boxes down.

Student "Defender" obstacles are NOT allowed to move but can swing pool noodles around...**If a box falls to the ground it cannot be picked up and is considered a ruined pizza!**

The team who delivers the most pizza boxes to the other end zone will win 1st place battle points., 2nd place= 2nd place battle points.
3rd place = 3rd place battle points

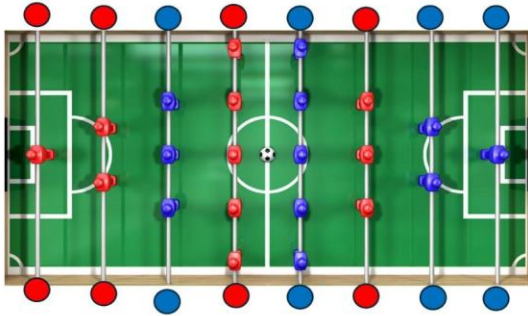
Kahoot Style Team Trivia

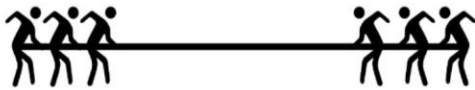
Human Foosball



Players are positioned facing the opposing team's goal. Players must have both hands on the rope handles **at all times and can only move LEFT & RIGHT.** This applies to each **GOALIE** as well.

Team Supports **HOLD ROPES** tightly on sidelines and act as barriers to keep the ball in bounds. Each team will face each other once. Team with the most goals after the time period win "the match".

Match Wins = 12 Battle Points
